The course originated out of the necessity for a better connection between higher vocational fashion education and the international work field. 10 years of Fashion Institute Arnhem will be celebrated this year – today, with the graduation show of the 10th generation, and later this year, with a big presentation at the Arnhem Fashion Biennale.

RENEWABLE AS AN INSPIRATION: TETRA PAK CHALLENGES CREATIVE STUDENTS

Tetra Pak, market leader in sustainable packaging, teamed up with rising stars of the Fashion Institute Arnhem (FIA, generation 11) for the occasion of the Amsterdam International Fashion Week. The fashion students designed items using packaging materials put at their disposal by Tetra Pak. The synergy resulted in unique fashion that will be shown tonight on the Zuiveringshal's catwalk at the Westergas site in Amsterdam.

In co-operating with these young ambitious designers Tetra Pak will hopefully contribute to their first international fashion footprint. The packaging multinational promotes working with renewable resources as a core value, which requires creativity and innovation. "It is the creative and innovative talent of these students, that we need, and therefore stimulate", says Roderick Friend, Business Development & Key Account Director at Tetra Pak Benelux.

PROTECTS WHAT'S GOOD

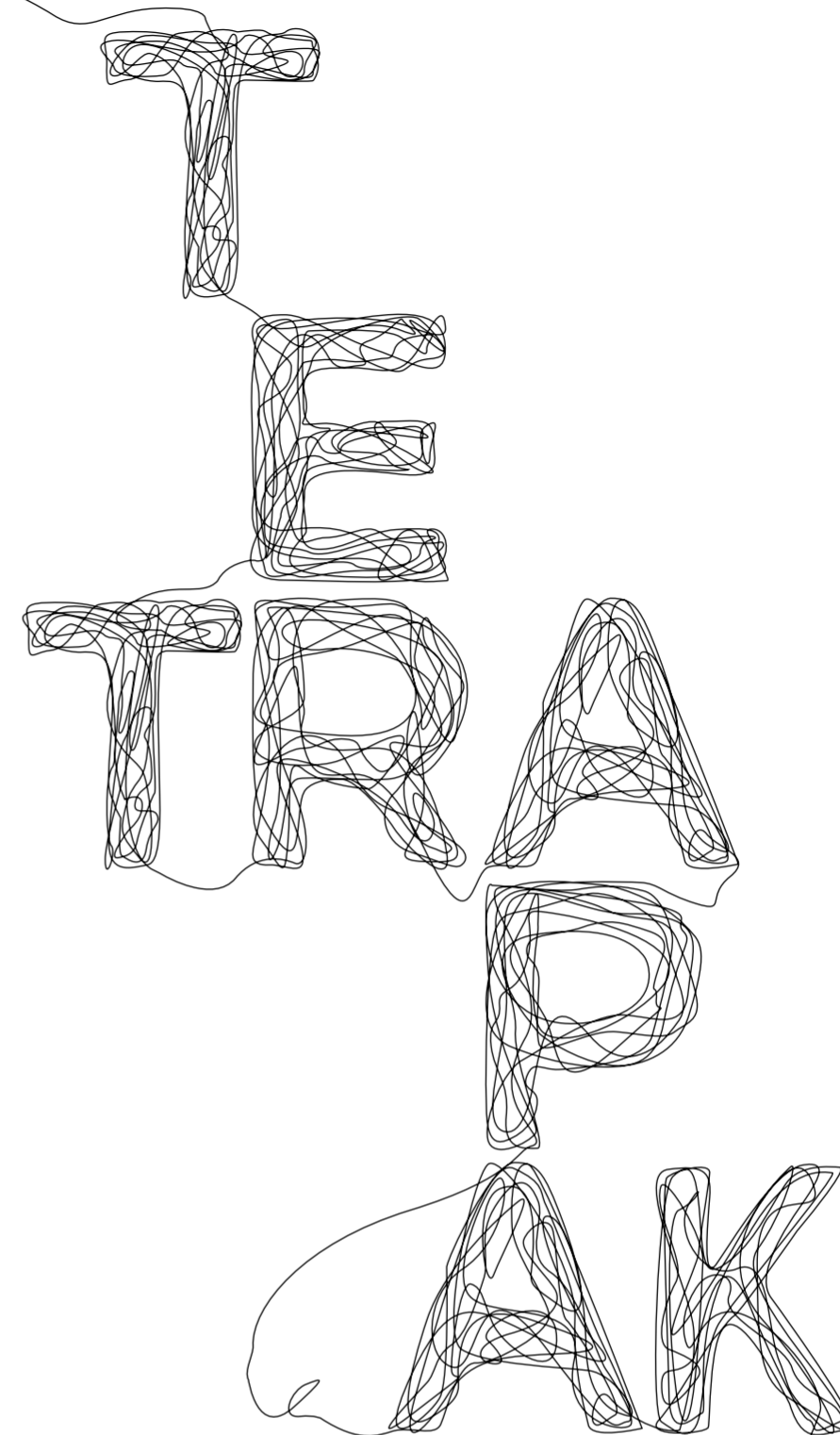
Friend: "We specifically aimed for fashion creatives. Our motto 'PROTECTS WHAT'S GOOD' not only refers to conservation of natural resources – we want to create opportunities for innovative out-of-the-box minds as well. We believe that these open-minded students can shed a new light on sustainability and the use of renewable resources and in that way contribute to the development of structural solutions.

"Furthermore 'protects what's good' also entails protecting the contents, in order to preserve valuable nutrients like vitamins. Also for models with hectic working rhythms, being fit is crucial and healthy products support an active lifestyle", adds Friend.

"Generation 11" can use Tetra Pak's corporate philosophy as an ample source of inspiration. The multinational produces creative packaging in an innovative and responsible manner. Renewable carton board forms the principal component of the packaging produced by Tetra Pak. The trees used for the production of the carton board are replanted by means of conscientious and mostly certified forestry management. That way the wood contingency remains stable and Sweden, the main supplier of the wood, remains green and rich in oxygen.

CREATIVITY WE NEED

"Some call us a CSR champion, others associate it with environmental friendliness, but what we really consider the most important is our corporate philosophy, that actually transcends these notions: the will to contribute to new ways of thinking, working and even living, that will help us out in the long run. In addition to supporting several charities that we believe in, we want to help create sustainable solutions. This obviously requires hard work and creativity", Friend knows.

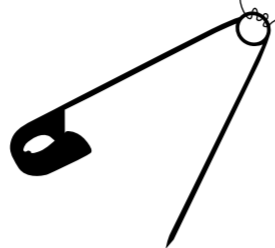

‘EEN KLEREMANS’

My men are sons of thunder. ‘Heren van Koster’ are rude butterflies. Gorgeous, dirty butterflies. They wear mismatched socks, often with holes in them. They have beards, moustaches and body hair. After a sunny day a singlet print is visible on their bodies. Without shame they wear a stained pair of designer trousers. They are not easily intimidated: maybe it’s even impossible. To design clothes for them is a great challenge!

These men feed me, and obviously, they are a great inspiration for my clothes.

For the ‘Een kleremans’ collection I wanted to make great clothes for ‘Heren van Koster’ – for walking, dancing, sitting, running. All day every day.

The ‘Een kleremans’ collection shows treated fabrics, a manipulated men’s silhouette and cool color effects. By adding extra layers of fabric, the clothes manipulate the silhouette and the shape of the wearer – both visible and invisible. Volumes are added on the knees and shoulders. The tight fit on the chest and on the back of the legs of the trousers create an innovative profile.

There is a tension between the men’s body and the clothes that He wears... it makes you wonder what’s underneath.

‘DAWN’

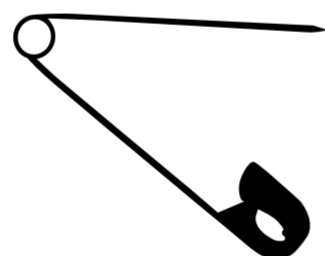
At sunrise, light beats dark. Colours enter.

I want to create an atmosphere. An atmosphere of refinement and sensitivity. Not based on reality but on a self-shaped fantasy, light and colourful.

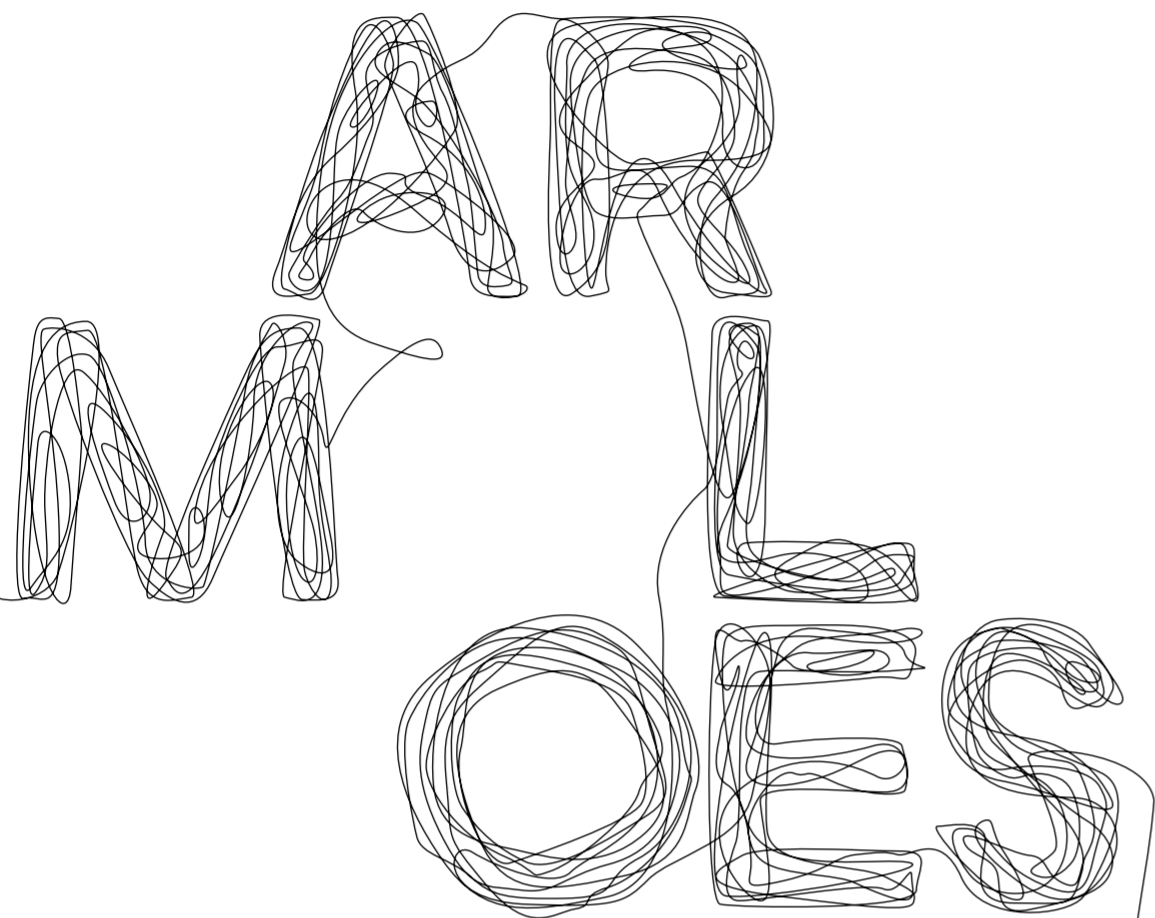

‘IF YOU MELT A SUIT, YOU’LL GET A DRESS’

The collection ‘If you melt a suit, you’ll get a dress’ is based on the idea of a striptease from a suit, slowly into a dress. For this collection, I was inspired by Dita Von Teese and her burlesque strip-acts in which she gracefully and sensually undresses herself.

The shapes are developed by literally taking a tailleur and producing it in softer and more feminine materials. Finally, it becomes a dress and disappears into lingerie.

The colours are based on the black and white contrast of a suit, the naked skin and sensual orange.
